
# Chair of Board of Examiners Summary

- All results have been marked and moderated using the CIBD Examination Board protocols and have been approved and signed off by the CIBD Chair of Board of Examiners
- Pass marks for the October 2025 examination sessions were in alignment with standards set for the Foundation examinations (NB: the pass marks can be skewed by smaller cohorts)
- On average, candidates only used 52% of the 1 hour 30 minutes allotted to the examination (NB: examination time prior to October 2025 cycle was 2 hours)
- Generally, topics were well covered across the syllabus units in all examinations




# Examination Board Results: October 2025

# General Comments

## Scope of Examination

The Foundation examinations test knowledge across the full breadth of the syllabus and whilst candidates are not guaranteed to be asked questions on absolutely everything, they still need to be prepared to answer questions on all topics.

Therefore, to ensure a positive result when taking the examination, candidates must ensure that they have fully engaged with the learning materials and any additional recommended study time or wider reading, as well as ensuring revision of the full breadth of the syllabus.

## Reading and Understanding

Candidates should ensure they read the question wording carefully and be certain they answer the question being asked. If in doubt, candidates can use the 'flag' function in TestReach to select a question that they wish to come back to and check they have read what the question is asking or re-check the answer they have chosen.

## Multiple responses

Candidates should always double-check how many answers are required for each question. In a small number of instances, two (2) answers are needed to get the full mark. Candidates must ensure they select **both** answers to get the mark.
